







OVERVIEW OF DEN

- Ownership: City and County of Denver, Department of Aviation
- Land size: DEN ranks as the second largest airport in the world with 53 square miles (34,000 acres)
- **Passengers**: DEN ranks as the 5th busiest airport in North America and the 17th busiest in the world with 54million passengers in 2015
- **Employees**: 33,000 people hold a badge to work at DEN; 2nd largest employer in CO; 1200 city employees
- Runways: Six non-intersecting runways with room to grow to 12
- Parking: More than 40,000 parking spaces
- **Elevation**: 5431 feet above sea level




CURRENT AERIAL VIEW OF DEN AIRFIELD

• Teflon coated fiberglass as thin as a credit card covering 1.5 million square feet






BRIDGE TO CONCOURSE A






